

CHAPTER: INSTRUCTION
TITLE: HOMEWORK

Homework is to be assigned to provide students practice in using what has been taught in class. Teachers are to assure that no new concepts are introduced in homework assignments. Teachers are to assess the homework and provide immediate feedback to students by making corrections and specific comments on improvements that can be made. This may be accomplished by various instructional methods as deemed appropriate by the teacher. Problems and remedies are to be discussed with individual students or the whole class as the homework is to be a demonstration of skill level for the purpose of working toward mastery of objectives. Further, teachers should use the following as a guide for assigning homework.

K: a maximum of 15 minutes per night

1-4: a maximum of 30 minutes per night

5-8: a maximum of 60 minutes per night

9-12: a maximum of 90 minutes per night

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
