

CHAPTER: INSTRUCTION
TITLE: WORK-BASED LEARNING

PURPOSE:

In accordance with the West Virginia State Board of Education Policy 2510, Calhoun County Students in grades 9-12 will be provided work-based learning experiences. These experiences must have the demonstrated ability to assist the student in attaining the Process/Workplace Objectives as defined in West Virginia State Board Policy 2520.

REQUIREMENTS:

Each student in Calhoun County will be required to complete a minimum of one day of job shadowing. Additionally, students will be offered elective work-based offerings. The work-based learning experience shall be related to the student's career cluster and/or major or interests. It is not required that the work-based learning experience occur during the regular school day or within the school calendar.

PROCEDURES:

Refer to the Calhoun County Work-Based Learning Handbook.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

The policy shall be in effect for grades 9-12 for students entering grade 9 in the 1999-2000 school year. Students entering under the previous work-based learning policy are excluded from the work-based learning requirement.
