

CHAPTER: INSTRUCTION

TITLE: USE OF NON-TRADITIONAL INSTRUCTIONAL DAYS (NTID)

Calhoun County Schools will utilize up to five Non-Traditional Instructional Days (NTID) annually which will be subject to state board approval. Through alternative methods of instruction, teachers will assign and grade student work that will be completed during days of canceled school for reasons such as inclement weather or because of other unforeseen circumstances. Any accrued bank time will be utilized first to make up the canceled instructional days. Then, up to five Non-Traditional Instructional Days (NTID) will be utilized. After the use of NTID, the superintendent will make recommendations to the Board of Education regarding adjustments to the school's calendar to make up further lost instructional days. Any Outside School Environment (OS) days will be converted after the use of bank time and NTID days.
